Accident Procedure

- You will find the first aid box stored in the kitchen
- Enter the details of the accident in the accident book kept with the first aid kit.
- For serious accidents contact the Chairman/ Secretary (who may have to contact the Health and Safety Executive).

Serious accidents include:

- Any fracture other than to the fingers, thumbs or toes.
- Any amputation
- Dislocation of the shoulder, hip, knee or spine.
- A chemical or hot metal burn to the eye or any penetrating injury to the eye.
- Any injury resulting from electric shock leading to unconsciousness, requiring resuscitation or admittance to hospital for more than 24 hours.
- Any other injury – a) leading to hypothermia, heat-induced illness or unconsciousness, b) requiring resuscitation, or c) requiring admittance to hospital for more than 24 hours.
- Loss of consciousness caused by asphyxia or exposure to a harmful substance or biological agent.
- Either of the following conditions which result from the absorption of any substance by inhalation, ingestion or through the skin a) acute illness requiring medical treatment, or b) loss of consciousness.
- Acute illness which requires medical treatment where there is reason to believe that this resulted from exposure to a biological agent, its toxins or infected material.
- Any accident requiring a member of the public to receive hospital treatment or be attended by an ambulance.
